REFUND POLICY

Withdrawal up to and including the 4th week of school during 1st semester will result in a prorated refund for the first semester's tuition, excluding non-refundable deposits, classroom supply fees, and lab fees. Also included in this exclusion is a \$50 withdrawal fee per student, used to cover administrative costs, facilities usage, and insurance. Following that time period, prorated refunds are not available. Refunds are issued on a semester by semester basis. If yearly tuition has been paid in full, the second semester will be refunded in full. Refunds are based solely on full withdrawal, not partial participation.
